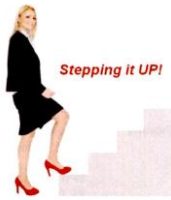

Cindy brings new energy and perspective to our membership and we are very pleased to have her as our newest member.



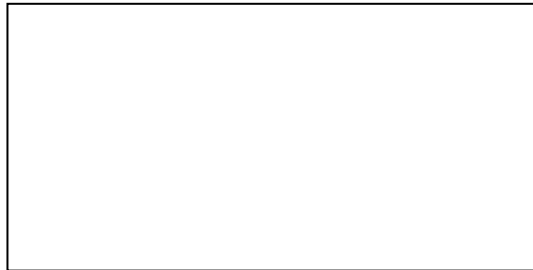
